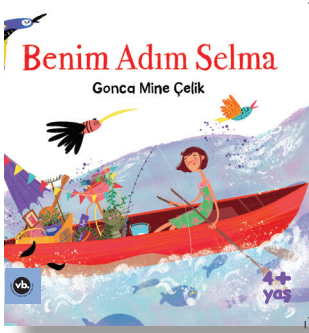


## My Name Is Selma
